



This chart shows an aggregation of results for New Hampshire middle and high schools that took the My Voice™ Survey during the academic year 2007-2008 and for which NECAP test score data was also available (N=115). NECAP data from 8th and 11th grades were used respectively.

The **Aspirations Composite Score (ACS)** for a particular school is an average of the sum of each student’s responses to the 8 Conditions statements on the My Voice Survey (after transposing “negative” responses, e.g. “I think bullying is a problem in my school”). The minimum ACS is 57; the maximum is 285. The three ranges represent low (N=36), middle (N=69), and high (N=10) scoring schools.

The **Academic Proficiency Average** is the average Academic Proficiency Score for schools in the corresponding Aspirations Composite Range.

Academic Proficiency Score is an average of the sum of the percentage of students who scored at the proficiency level and above on NECAP reading, math, and written standardized tests for a particular school.
